

Team Wales Glasgow 2014

Deputy to Chef de Mission

Essential criteria

- Experience of leadership role in Sport
- Experience of working with a senior Games Management Team in Multi-sport Games, with at least one of those with team Wales at Commonwealth Games
- Confirmed availability for the Games period from soft open until last members of team leave Village - July 8th until August 4th or 5th 2014
- Confirmed availability for Chef de Mission seminar in Spring 2014- approximately one week.
- Confirmed availability to attend visits to Glasgow, one with team managers in 2014, at least one other earlier in cycle
- In addition confirmed availability for the following CGCW events:-
 - Two team manager training weekends, one in 2013 and the other in 2014,
 - CGCW Board meetings as requested (2pm start on a Wednesday),
 - All CGCW Executive meetings, (5pm start- probably 6 a year in 2013 and 2014)
 - Other Senior Management committee meetings as requested by CGCW CEO
 - Fitting sessions and Team days as arranged
- Availability as set out in the job description to meet with CGCW CEO and to respond to Glasgow 2014 requests
- Good communication skills
- Ability to closely support the Chef de Mission
- Ability to motivate and encourage all Team Wales members
- Ability to work under pressure both before and during a Games
- Ability to work closely as a member of a tight management team
- Familiarity with Zeus Games management system and train to a higher standard
- Be in good health and able to withstand the rigours of travelling with and working with the team

Desired criteria

- Good media skills
- Ability to communicate in the Welsh language
- Ability to make excellent decisions
- Have proven ability to establish harmonious relationships with athletes, coaches, team managers and other support staff
- Have a good working knowledge of Welsh sporting Bodies
- Ability to work closely with all stakeholders
- Sense humour and ability to handle large amounts of information
