



Job Description: Community Coach

Job Title:	Community Netball Coach
Responsible to:	Coach Education Coordinator
Salary:	£15 per hour
Based at:	Various Netball Clubs in area
Hours:	Approx. 4 hours per week Sept- Apr (possibility for extension)

Main purpose: (i.e. why the job exists)

To plan, deliver and evaluate a co-ordinated programme of high quality coaching activities in specific netball clubs to enhance the level of coaching and encourage the development of newly qualified volunteers.

Key Tasks

1. Plan and deliver a coaching programme to stimulate participation specific to players needs within a specified club in order to promote player/ club improvement
2. Support and steer existing club coaches towards improvement and best practice
3. Identify and recruit 2 new coaches at each club, acting as mentor and assisting in their development over the period of time working with the club.
4. Contribute to increase participation (membership) within the club
5. Work with clubs to achieve club mark accreditation (progress to next level where applicable)

Additional Tasks

1. To continually promote top quality coaching and netball in general
2. Commit to personal improvement and development and actively work towards next coaching level (this could involve progression to UKCC qualifications)
3. Establish a good working relationship with clubs and appropriate organisations and associations

Additional Information

1. As the post involves working with children and young people, the post holder will be required to undergo an advanced Criminal Records Bureau check.
2. This post requires the post holder to regularly carry out work during evening and weekend periods.

The successful applicant will have a proven track record in coaching and performance, hold a Welsh Netball (or equivalent) Level 2 coaching qualification (Experienced Level 1 coaches may apply); possess the ability to share good practice and mentor newly qualified coach volunteers and have access to own transport.
