

HELEN WESTON NOMINATED FOR PRESTIGIOUS AWARD

Welsh Netball is proud to announce that Helen Weston has been nominated for inclusion in the Welsh Sports Hall of Fame Roll of Honour.

The Roll of Honour was formed in 1980 to provide a Welsh national focus for recognising and preserving sporting achievements by Welsh sportsmen and sportswomen at the highest level, with the intention of influencing future generations in the values of sporting endeavour. There are no representatives from netball on the Roll of Honour to date.

A celebratory dinner is being held on **Friday 22nd June (evening)** at Cardiff City Hall where Helen will receive her award.

At the dinner, new additions to the Roll of Honour are announced. The dinner is normally attended by major figures in the political, sporting, commercial and media fields and a total of up to 400 people with interest and involvement in Welsh sport, and is covered by the main television and newspaper companies.
