### **Background information**

NE is the Federation of European Netball Associations with seven full affiliated country members. These are England, Gibraltar, Malta, Northern Ireland, Republic of Ireland, Scotland and Wales. Recently Israel joined as an associate member. NE will continue to grow and seek new European countries to join our Association.

NE was established in 1989 when the International Federation of Netball Associations (IFNA), created five regions - Africa, Americas, Asia, Europe and Oceania.

A small Management Committee administers NE and finance comes from an annual fee and a rulebook levy from member countries. Annual international competitions are run for members at various age groups.
