



NETBALL DEVELOPMENT OFFICER

North East Wales Institute of Higher Education (NEWI) under the management of its subsidiary company Plas Coch Sports Limited in partnership with Sport Flintshire and the Welsh Netball Association are seeking applicants with the drive and initiative to develop netball in Flintshire and Wrexham.

The post holder will continue to develop netball both within Wrexham and Flintshire, undertaking the Strategic development objectives of both areas in line with the Welsh Netball Associations Strategic Plan. The post holder will ensure the continued improvement in standards of service delivery through participation via school links, coach education and mentoring, community club development and opportunities for potential progression pathways. They will also develop a recognised progression from Further Education through to Higher Education using sport as a vehicle to underpin the continuation of education. The post holder hopes to enhance the opportunity for netball players through the strategic development of regional associations to sustain the development of the netball from participation to excellence.

The successful applicant will need to demonstrate an understanding of key work areas including: sports development, netball coaching principles and funding opportunities for schools and clubs in each county. They will need to hold a recognised netball coaching qualification, have a thorough knowledge of netball and be able to demonstrate the skills and qualities needed to make a significant contribution to the growth of netball in Wales.

The successful applicant will develop and oversee the delivery of the Community Club Project, identify and deliver training for coaches, umpires, volunteers, assist in the establishment of Centres of Development and Coach at the Talent Centres situated at both NEWI and in Flintshire. Applicants will need to be self-motivated and be prepared to work unsociable hours.

This job will be multidisciplinary and will require the post holder to work within two differing counties; having office and administrative facilities both within Flintshire and Wrexham.
